



New Haven Community School District Learning Loss Plan

New Haven Elementary::

Staff will use data collected from their Reading Benchmark program for K-3 in the 2 areas of Comprehension and Phonics, to develop lessons that address & support these areas. The program will be 2-3 days a week for one hour a session. It will last for 12 weeks.

For 4th & 5th grade after school reading tutoring will be two days a week for 12 weeks.

Staff will use Math IXL K-5 to assign areas needing support as identified by NWEA fall testing.

Endeavour Elementary:

Staff will use data collected from their Reading Benchmark program for K-3 in the 2 areas of Comprehension and Phonics, to develop lessons that address & support these areas. The program will be 2-3 days a week for one hour a session. It will last for 12 weeks.

For 4th & 5th grade after school reading tutoring will be two days a week for 12 weeks.

Staff will use Math IXL K-5 to assign areas needing support as identified by NWEA fall testing.

Endeavour Middle School:

ELA: Staff will use ELA IXL to assign areas needing support as identified by NWEA fall testing.

Math: Staff will use NWEA testing from fall to identify and assign math in IXL that will help close gaps for each individual student. The staff will also support the students by revisiting the daily math work and reteaching concepts that students may be struggling with, as well as help students prepare for upcoming tests.

The program will be 3 days a week for one hour a session. It will last for 20 weeks.

High School:

Staff will work with students on daily assignments to assure students understand and are able to successfully complete assignments as well as help prepare for upcoming tests. Staff will also use IXL for Math and ELA to assign areas students need support with as identified by NWEA fall testing. The program will be 2-3 days a week for one hour a session. It will last for 20 weeks.

Elementary Summer School:

New Haven will run a 6 week summer school program, in partnership with the To provide training for students entering K-5th grade. Kinderconnect, First grade Fundamental, and Summer Scholars will be for targeted students not at grade Level. STEM and Literacy will be an enrichment for any student not in the Targeted program for students 2-5th grade.
