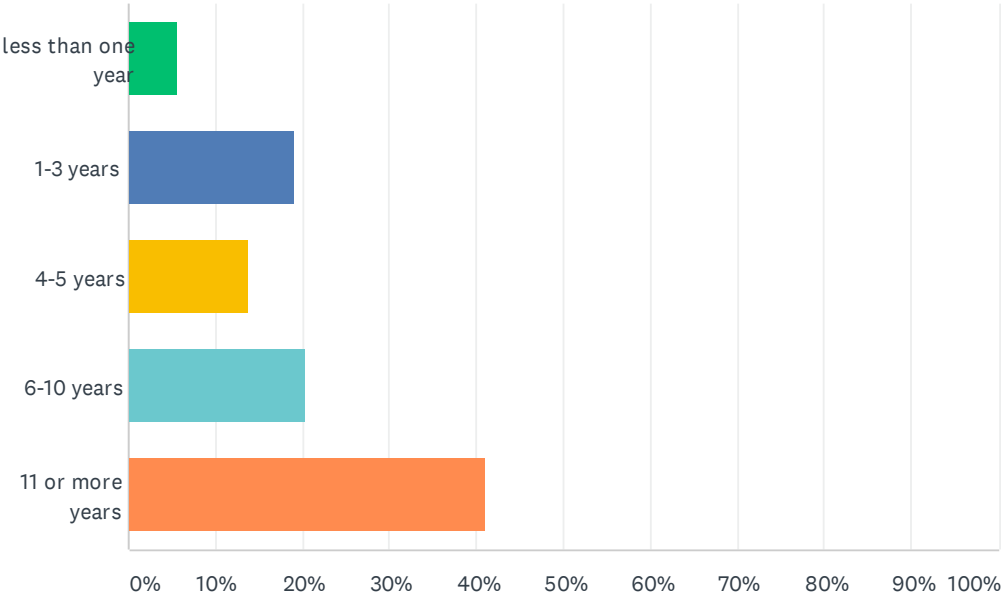


Q1 How many years have you lived in our school district?

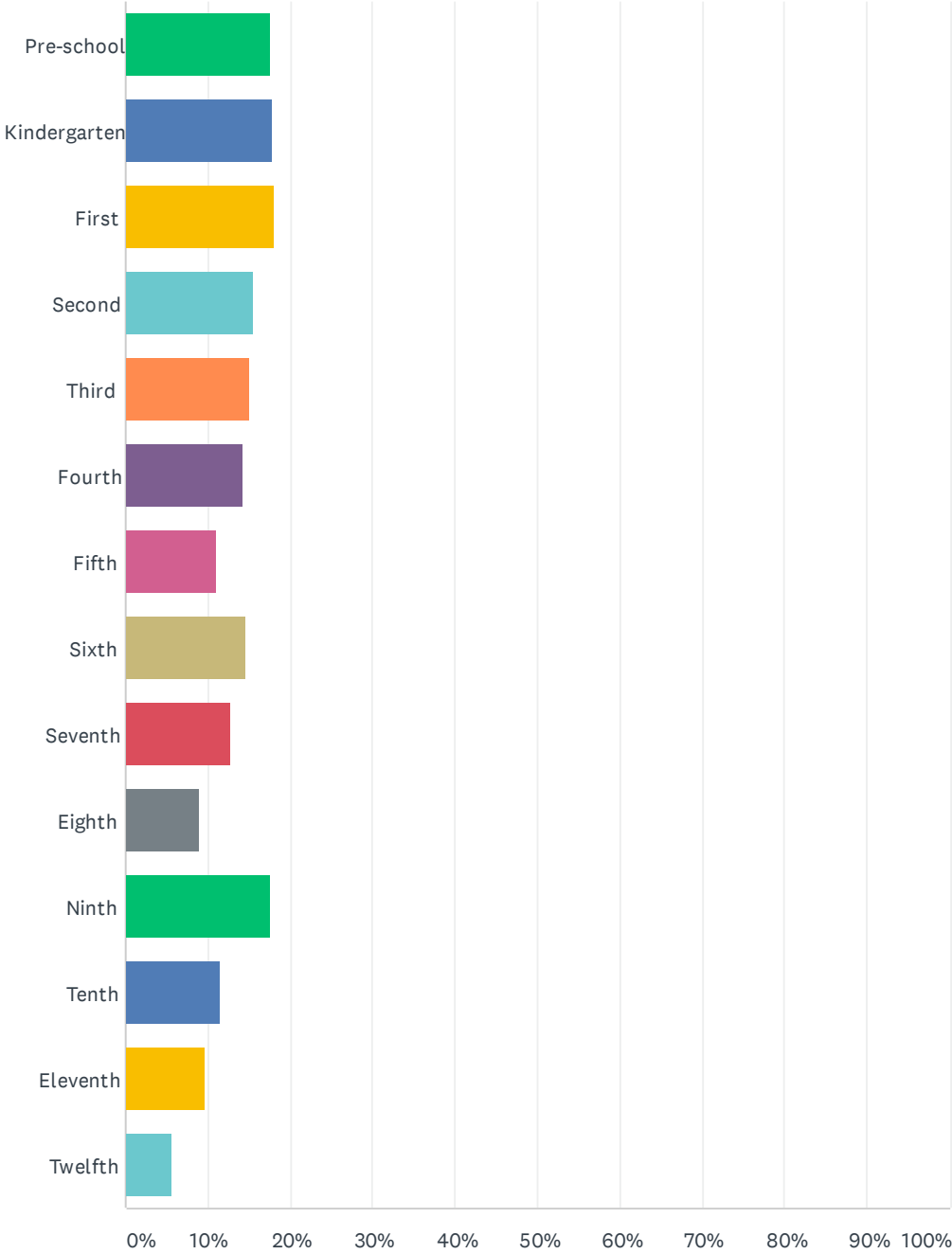

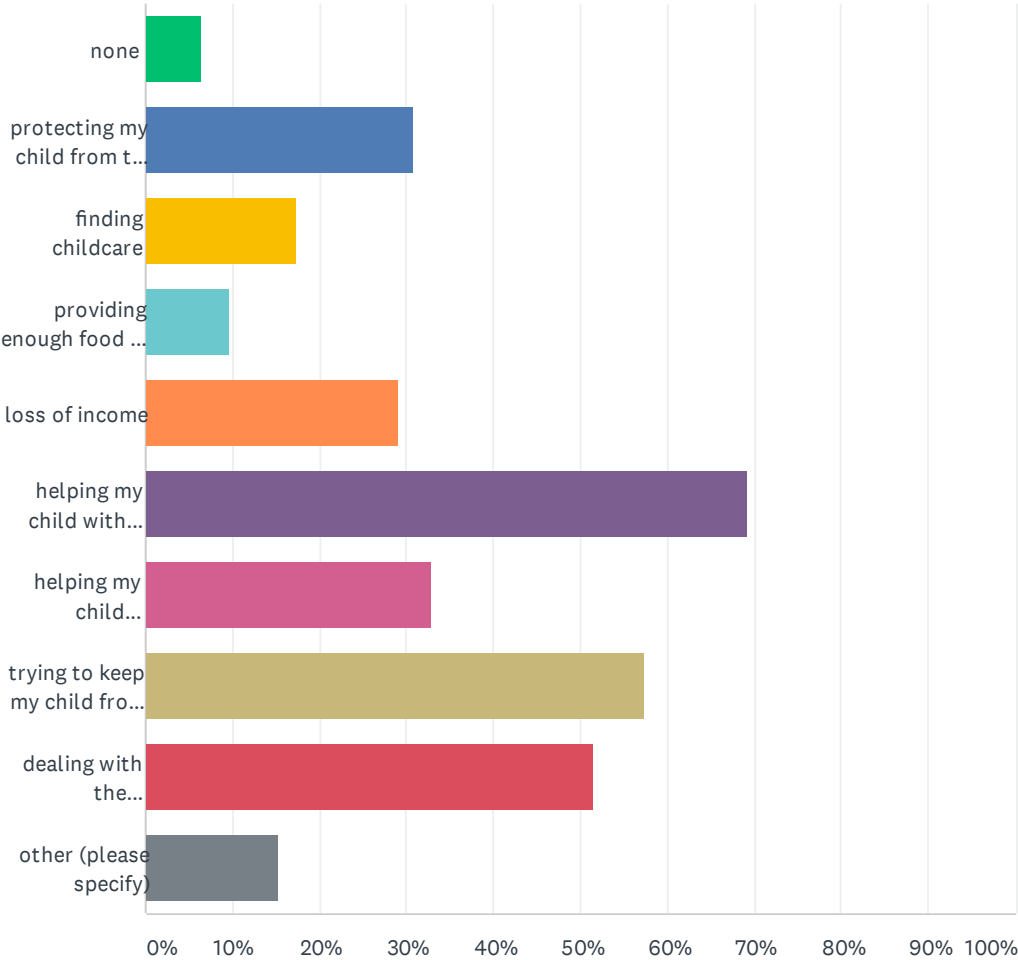

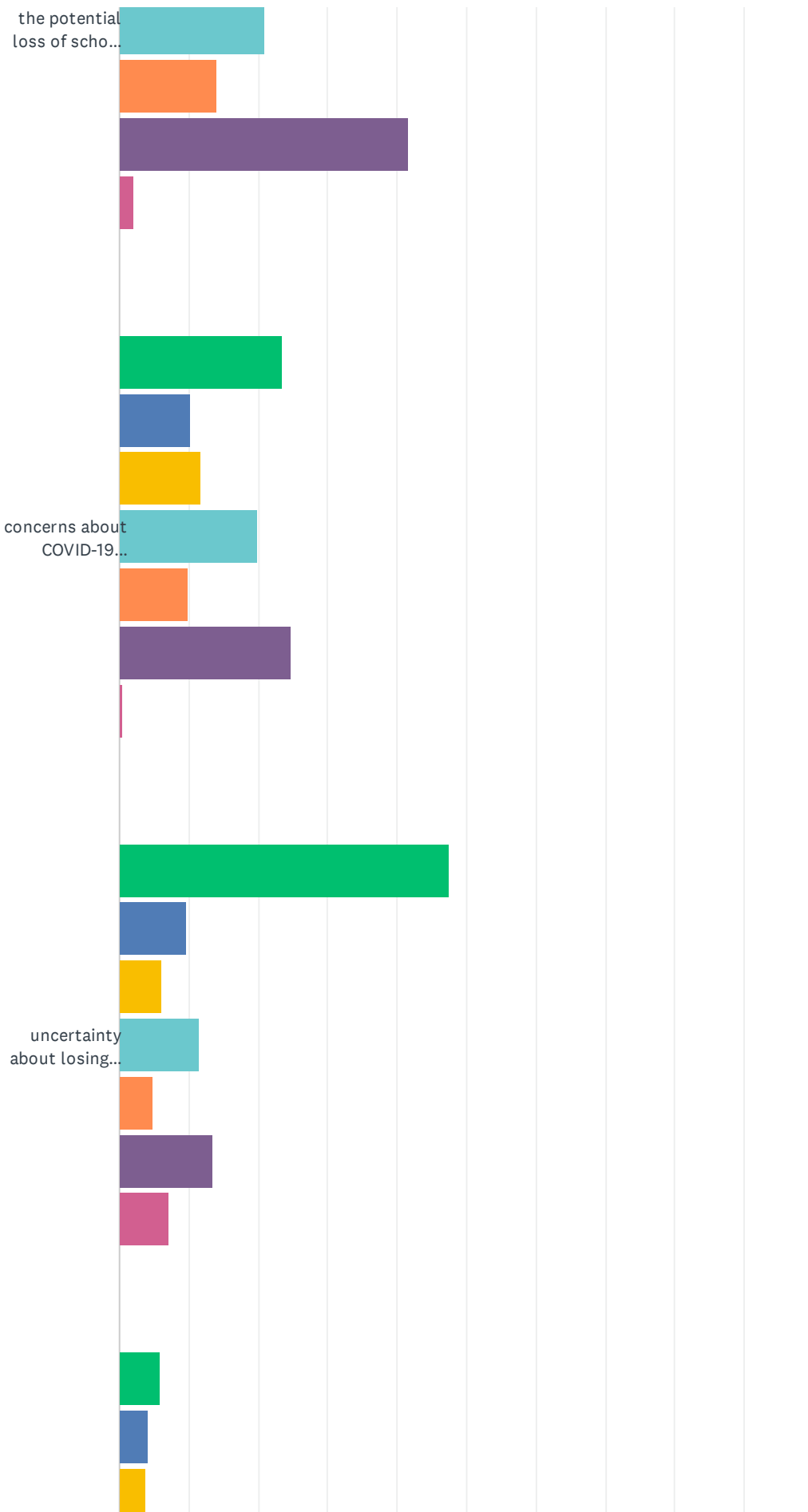

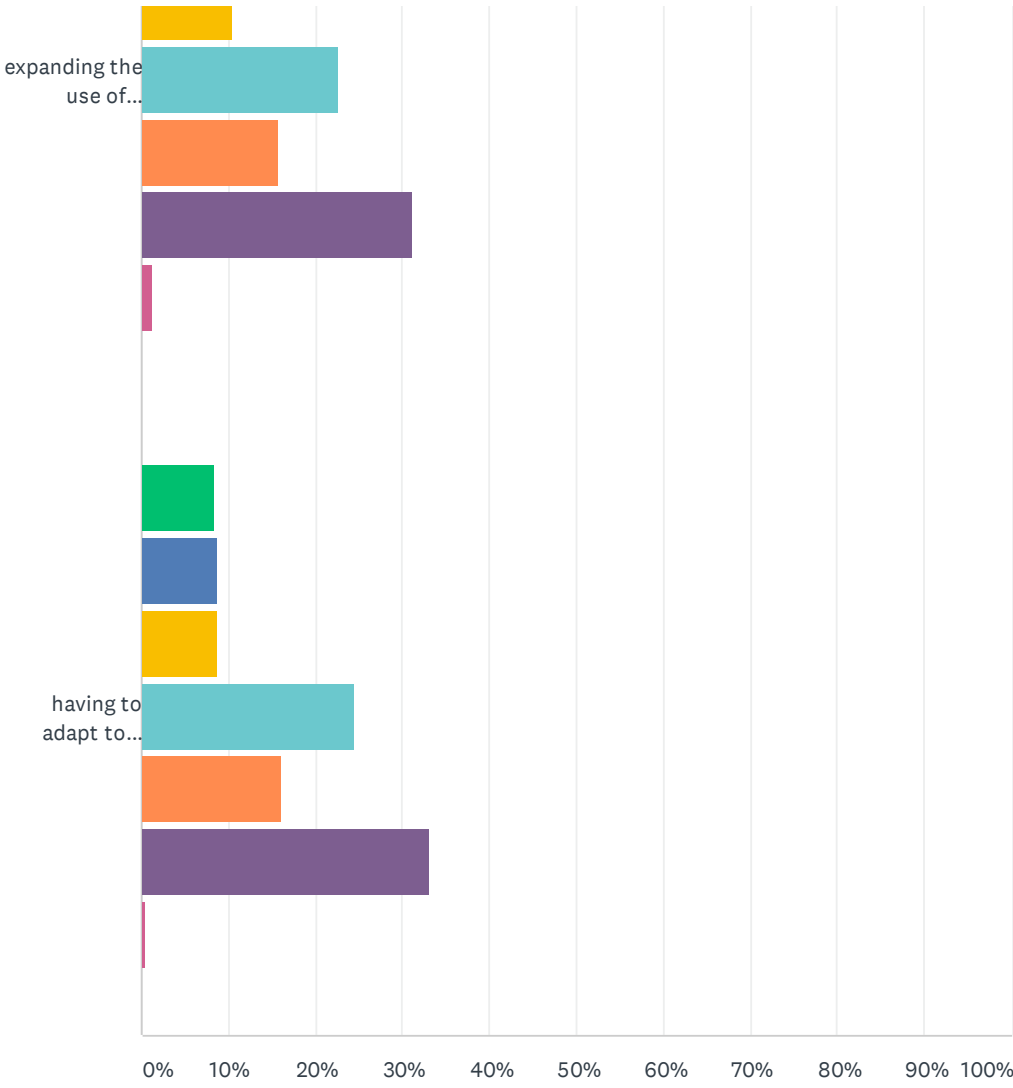

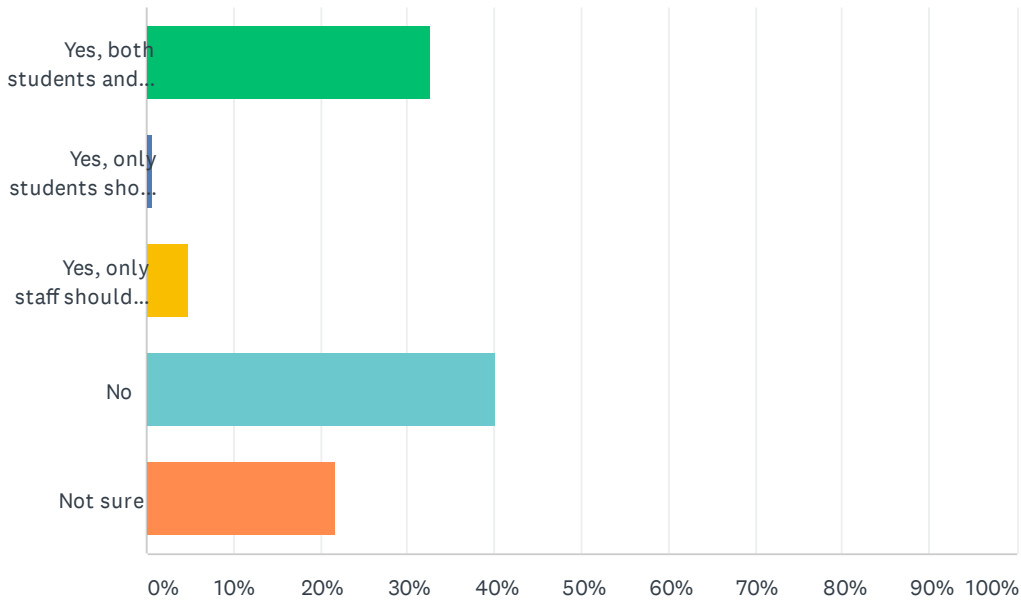

Q6 If the CDC or the Michigan Department of Education recommended that students and staff wear masks while school is in session, would you be comfortable complying with this recommendation?

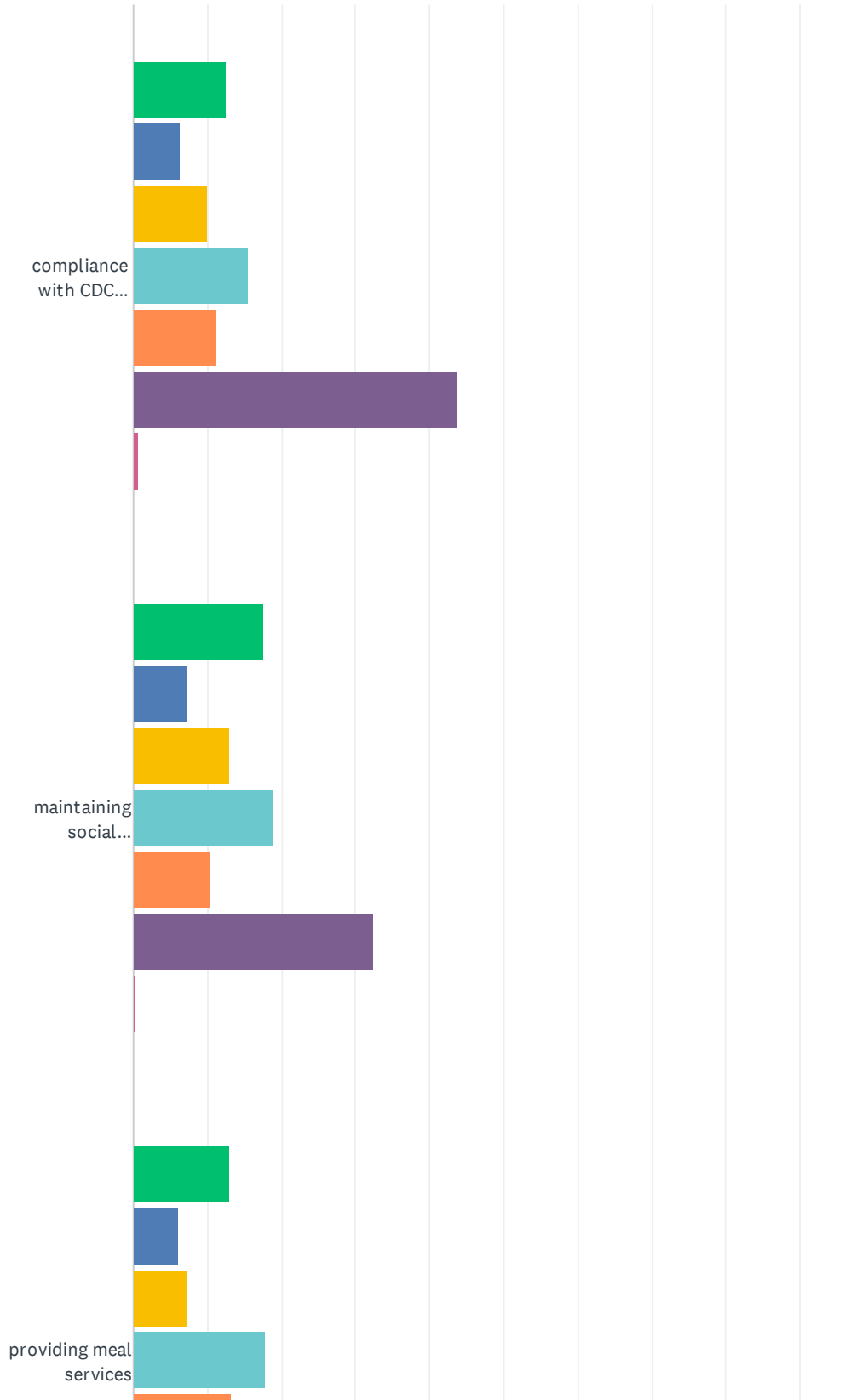

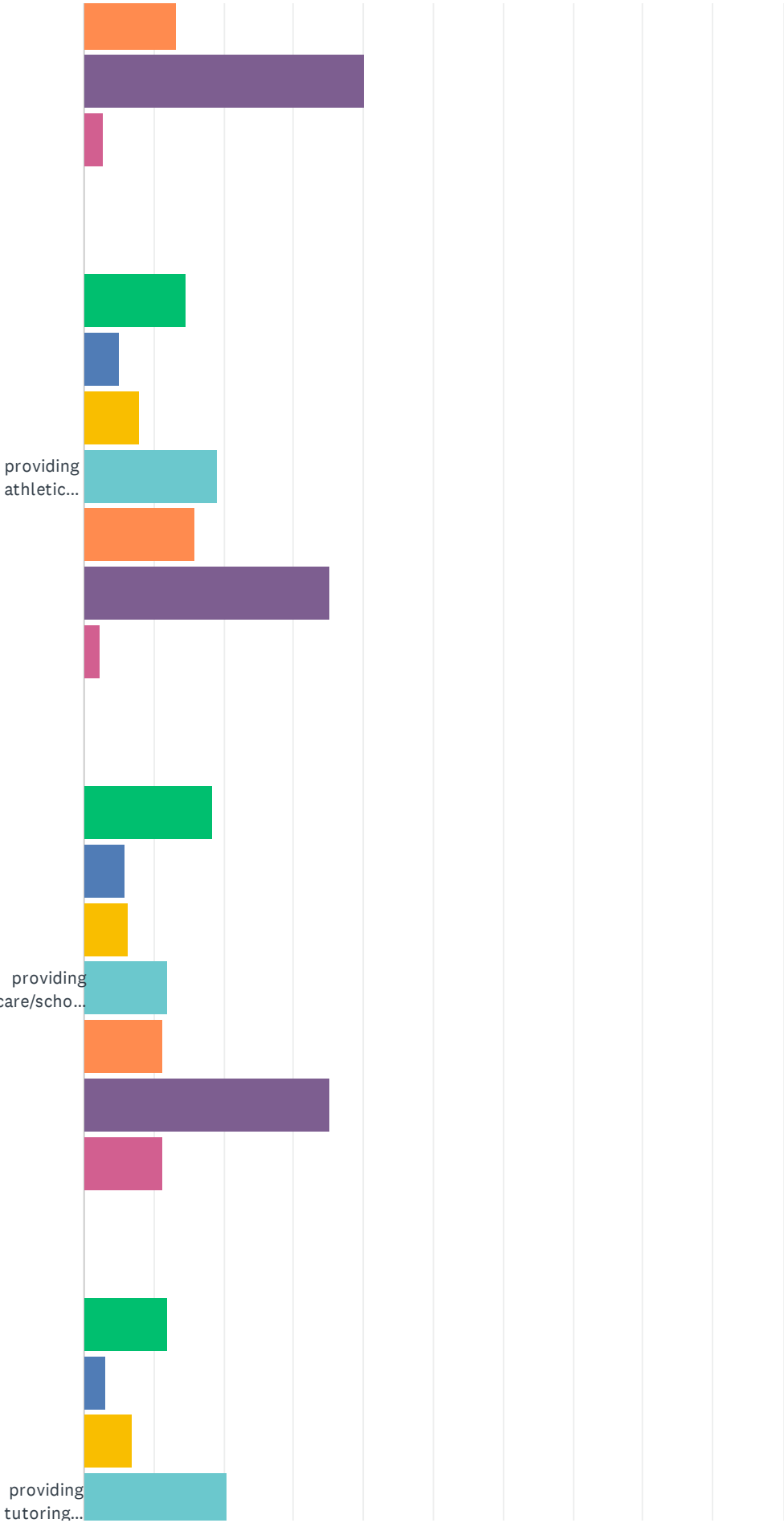

Q7 On a scale of 0 to 5 (where zero is low and five is high), please rate the importance of the following items when school re-opens:

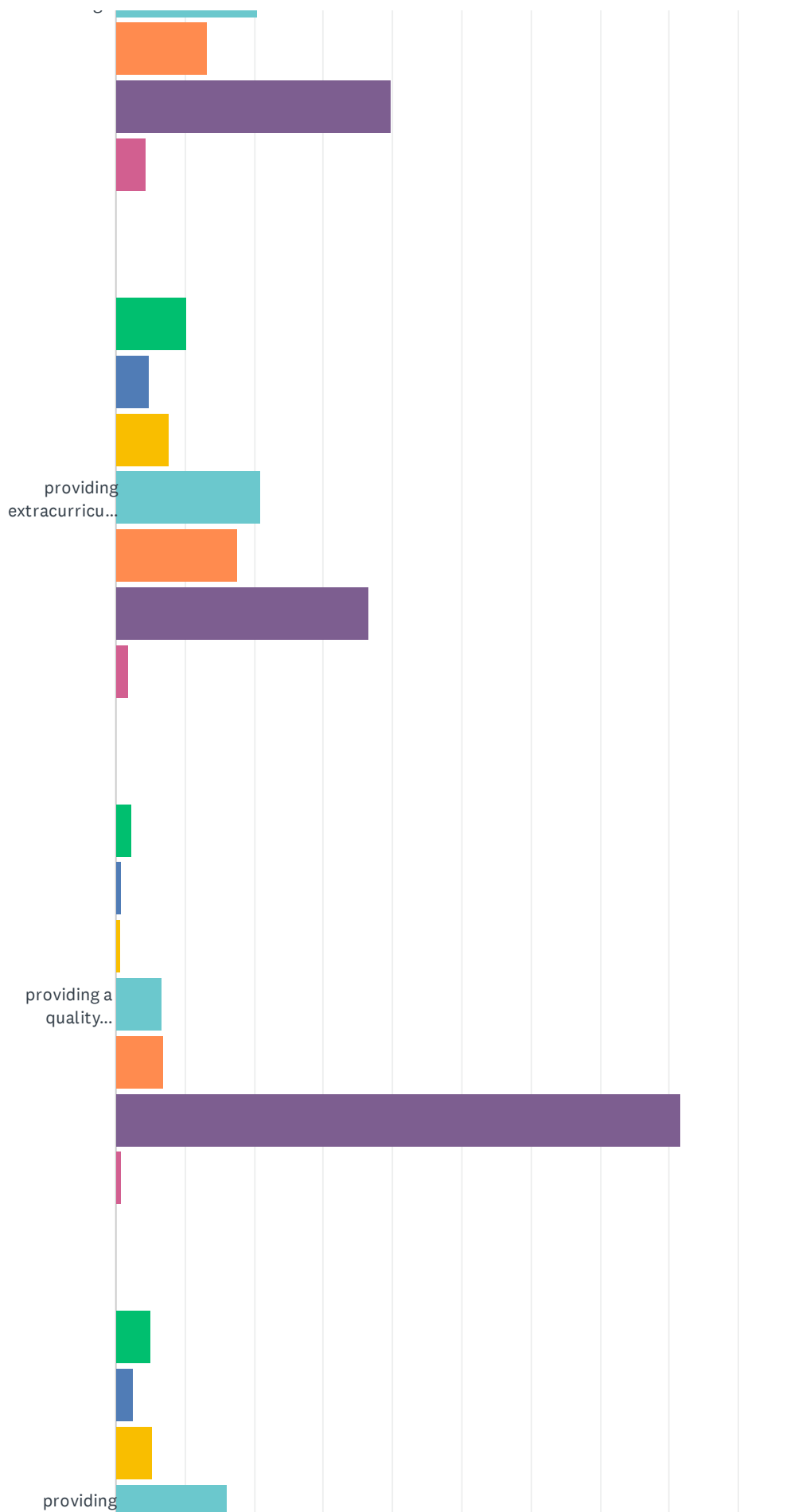

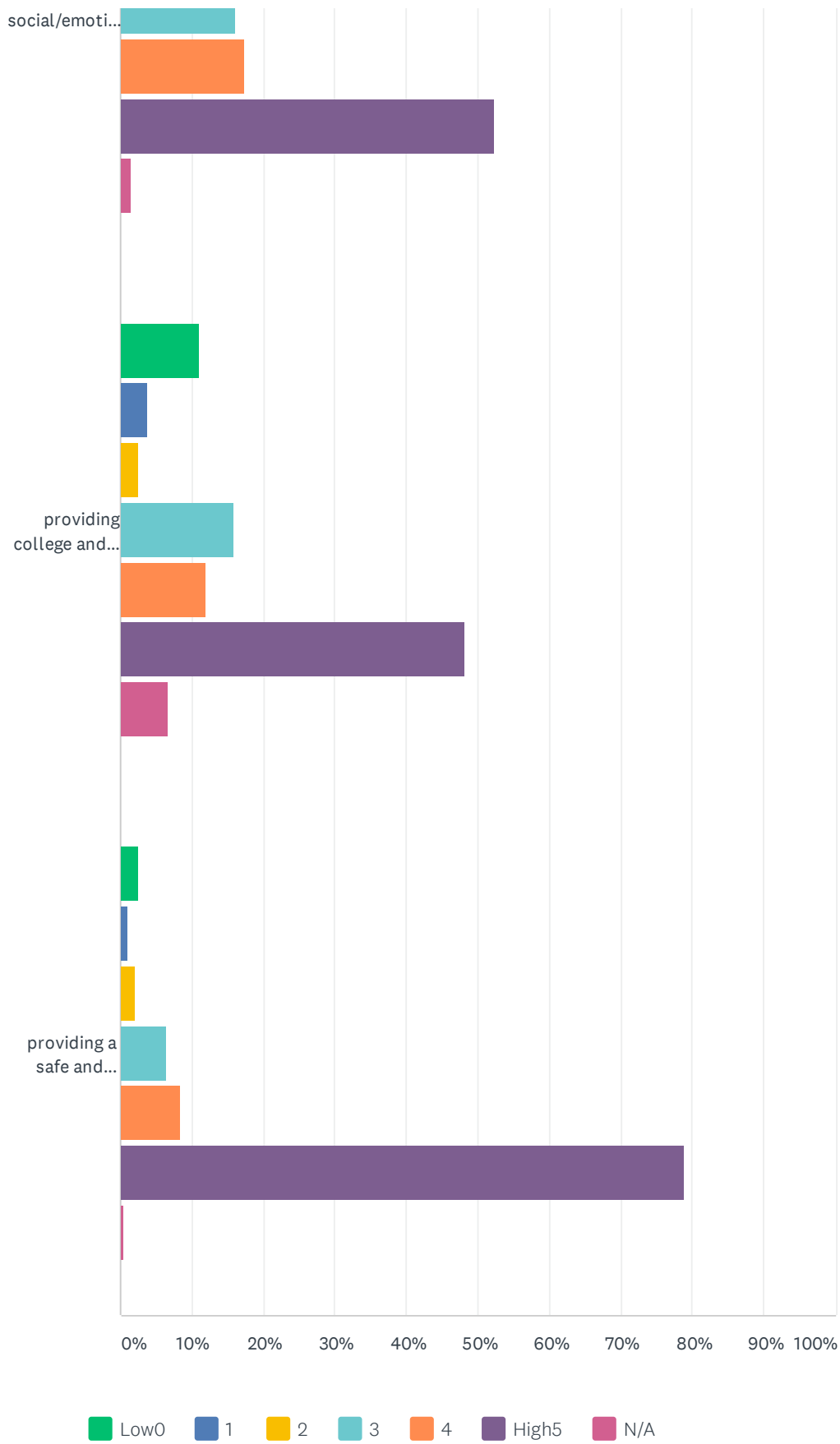

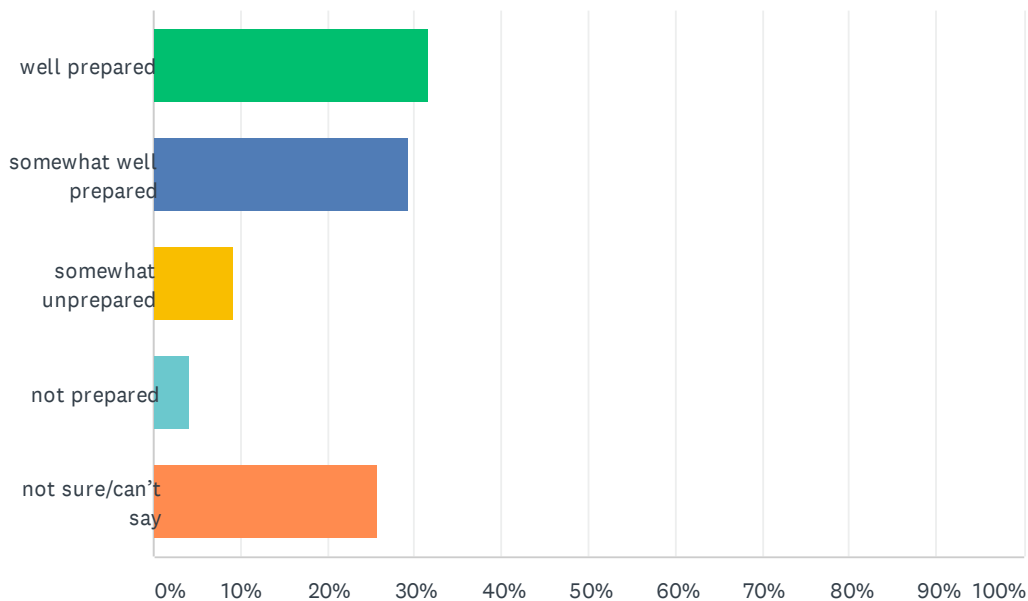

Q8 In your opinion, how well prepared will our school district be to offer a quality educational program when schools re-open?

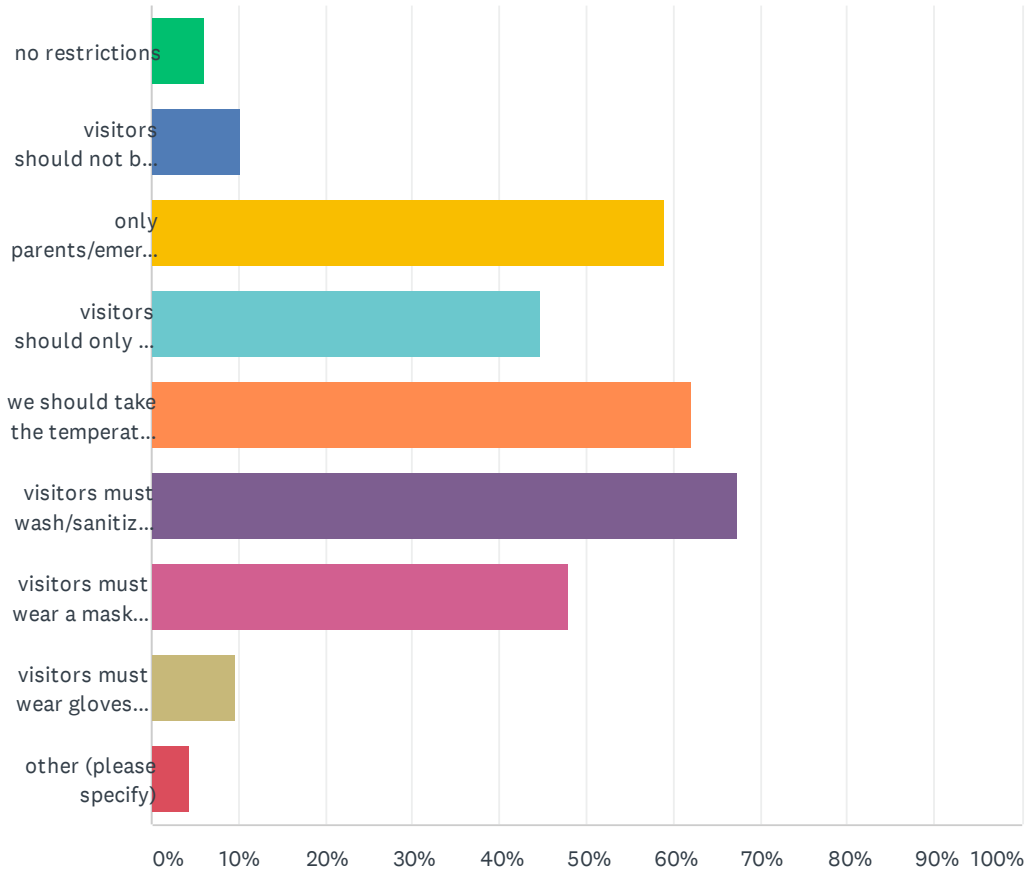

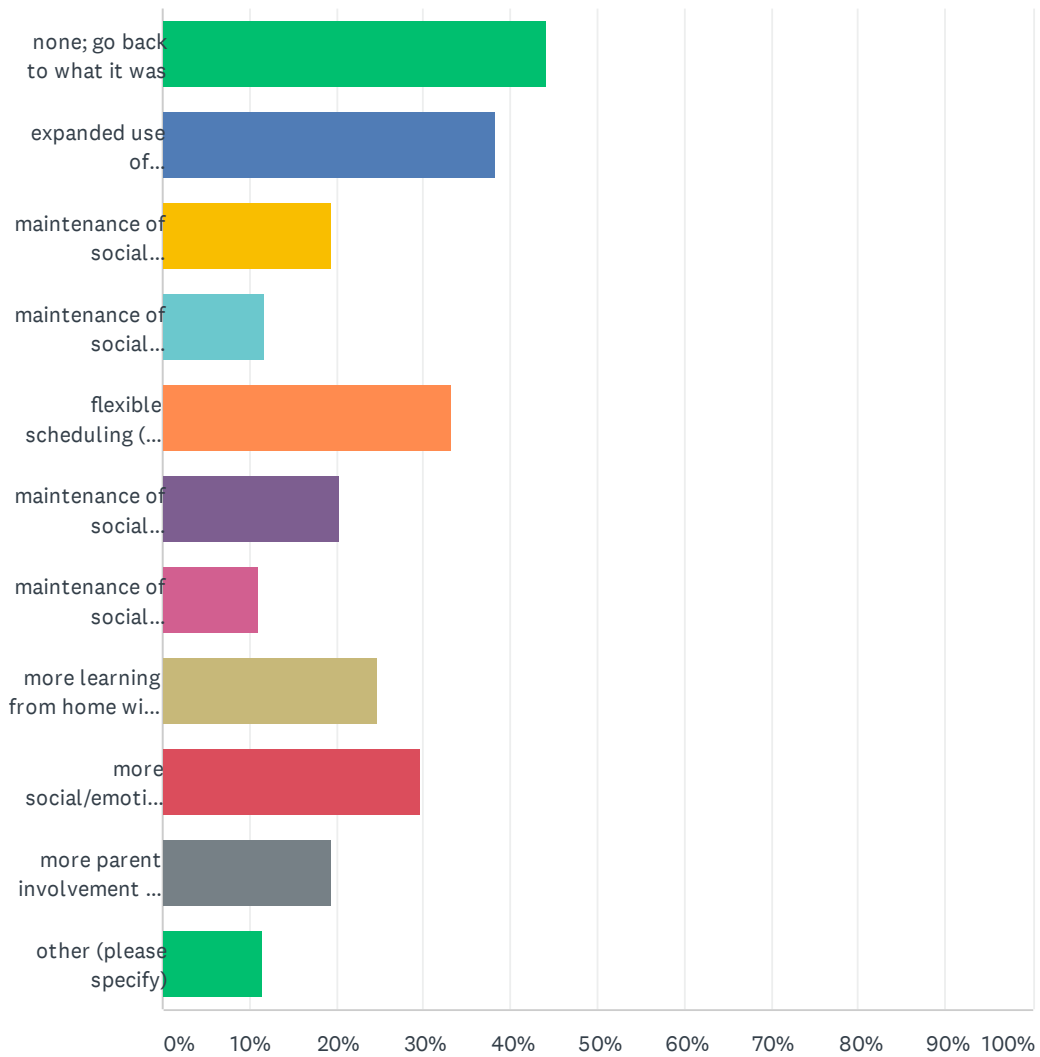
