- * Provide many opportunities for your child to read, write, speak and listen.
- * Reading Aloud is a great way to promote literacy. After finishing a book, talk to your child about what you read and reread if there is a favorite part.
- * Read the same stories again and again!!! Yes it will drive you crazy but hearing stories many times helps children memorize words.
- * Remember to pick books that interest your child.
- * Include books, poems, fairytales, magazines, diaries, newspapers and more.
- * Sing songs and do tongue twisters. This helps learn new sounds in words.
