Dear NHCS Families and Friends,

I hope this letter finds you safe and well. As times continue to change, our district remains committed to providing updates to the New Haven community. Your patience and flexibility is greatly appreciated as we move ahead into the next phase of coping with this public health crisis.

Today, Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order 2020-35 which states:

“Suspension of in-person K-12 instruction for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.” New Haven Community Schools is learning about the details of this Executive Order and will be developing a Phase 2-Continuity of Learning Plan. The traditional method of delivering instruction will continue to be different but it is critical that we continue providing instruction and support for our students. Details of this plan will be shared during the week of April 13.

In addition, a Phase 2-Food Distribution Plan will also be developed to continue supporting the nutritional needs of our children. Details of this plan will be shared very soon.

In the meantime, breakfast and lunch distribution will continue on Friday, April 3 via school bus routes. Pick-up at NHE will also continue from 9:30-10:15. Breakfast and lunch will be provided for 5 days.

THANK YOU to the many families that are meeting the bus at the end of their driveway to receive the packets from the doorway of the bus.

We ask that all families come to the door of the bus to receive the breakfast and lunch packets. We appreciate your cooperation.
