### **Program Criteria for Admission**

❖ Business Administration, Management & Operations No pre-requisites; Open to all 10-12 grade students.
❖ Graphics & Printing Technology and Communications No pre-requisites; Open to all 10-12 grade students.
❖ Computer Programming No pre-requisites; Open to all 9-12 grade students.
❖ Health Science/Allied Health No pre-requisites; Open to all 10-12 grade students.
❖ Automotive Technician/Technology No pre-requisites; Open to 9-12 grade students.
