

After School Tutoring Program – 2021/2022

Purpose:

To provide academic support to any and all New Haven High School students who require or desire it.

Where: New Haven High School Media Center

When: 2:20 to 3:20 Monday through Thursday

Who: Any New Haven High School student is welcome to take advantage of this service. Any student who has a 65%, or lower, in any core class will be required to attend After School Tutoring two days/week until grade exceeds 65%

Students who attend by choice

- May arrive and leave when they want
- Welcome to work in groups, use computers, listen to music (with headphones), etc.
- This is to be an enjoyable time for these students as long as they are working and not disturbing others

Students with a 65% or lower in any core class

- Required to attend 2 days per week until all core classes are above 65%
 - May choose days of the week
 - If miss a day, must make up within one week
 - If miss the make up, will receive 1 day ISS (academic suspension) to work with tutor all day to raise grades
 - Doors close by 2:20.
- Expectations
 - Must arrive on time and be ready to work entire hour
 - If more than 5 minutes late, the day will not count and will have to make up (but are welcome and encouraged to stay and work)
 - Arrive prepared to work the entire hour with all books and materials
 - May not leave Media Center
 - Work quietly the entire time
 - Student/teacher may run missing work report from PowerSchool
 - No food
 - Red Room – No electronic devices. Computer use only with permission of tutors and for academic purposes
 - Students not following rules will be asked to leave and day must be made up. No warnings will be given.
