


Letter of Agreement
between
The New Haven Paraprofessional Association, MEA-NEA
and
The New Haven Board of Education

The New Haven Board of Education, hereinafter referred to as "District," and the New Haven Paraprofessional Association, hereinafter referred to as "Association" hereby agree as follows:

1. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, if the District determines that a student(s) is medically fragile and requires a **trained** Paraprofessional/Aide to accompany the student on the bus, the Paraprofessional/Aide shall receive a one thousand dollar (\$1000) stipend paid in the last pay period of June.
2. Any necessary training will be provided, at no cost to the employee, during the contractual day. If the training must be provided outside the contractual day, the Paraprofessional/Aide will be paid his/her hourly rate.
3. For the 2021-2022 school year, the current Paraprofessional/Aide shall receive a \$100 stipend for the amount of days left in the 2021-2022 school year after the training took place.
4. Any and all future vacancies in these positions will be posted and filled in accordance with Article 13, Vacancies and Transfers, of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Association and District.


All other terms and conditions of the current Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA), as negotiated between the parties, shall remain in full force and effect.

This Agreement is non-precedent setting and contains the entire understanding between the parties and cannot be added to, changed, deleted from, and/or, in any other way, modified without further written agreement between the parties.
